Mobile phones

Please can we ask that mobile phones are not used when in the nursery. This is to safeguard all the children in our care. Staff will ask you to wait outside whilst using your mobile.

Door Security

To ensure our nursery is as safe as it can possible be for all the children we look after, we would like to ask your cooperation in using the front door and the door between Yellow stones and the reception area.

Firstly please can we ask that when entering and leaving the building that the front door is closed correctly behind you.

Also can we ask that the switch on the top latch is not touched. As without the catch sticking out the buzzer will not work. We ask this to ensure that the children cannot open the door themselves nor can anyone get in from outside without our permission.

Secondly can we also ask your cooperation in making sure that the door between the reception and Yellow Stones is close at all times. This is once again to prevent the children from being able to get into the reception area and ultimately prevent them from accessing the front door.

As always we appreciate all your support in ensure that the children who attend Moonstone Day Care are able to be safe and secure whilst in attendance.

Safeguarding

Safeguarding the children in our care is paramount. All staff members in the nursery have received safeguarding training and are able to deal with any issues that may arise.

Safeguarding however is everyone's responsibility and therefore we ask that if you see, hear or know anything which may cause you concern please do not hesitate to mention it to a staff member.

No smoking

Please note that our nursery and the premises surrounding it -including the car park are a No Smoking Area. This is for the health and safety of all who attend the nursery including children, staff, parents and visitors.



Medication

Please can we ask that you inform the nursery if your child has had medicine before being left with us.

This can be done verbally when speaking to a member of staff, via a message on my baby's day or via email.

It is really important you do this as in an emergency we may give children medication such as Calpol before contacting you which may cause us to overdose your child if we are unaware of previous doses.
